Workshop List

Some workshops will overlap so please check the times when making your choice. Workshops can be booked at the show on a first come, first served basis. Payment should be made by cash only.

Workshop 1

11.30am - 1 hour - £7.50

Appliqué Reusable Book Cover *with Angela Warburton (Quiltbloc)*

Use appliqué templates, different stitches and embellishments to create a reusable book cover, which can be finished at home.

12.45pm - 1 hour - £8.00

Needle Felted Landscapes *with Katharine Wright (Leicestershire Craft Centre)*

A great opportunity to have a go at needle felting – create a landscape of your choice and learn the technique of felting with a needle.

2.00pm - 1 Hour - £7.50

Create a Beautiful Batik Landscape *with Roxana Pallatt (Hannah's Room)*

Join Roxana Pallatt as she shows you how to create a simple yet effective landscape using beautiful batik fabrics. Participants will complete the basics of this scene during the workshop and then add stitching and embellishment at home.

Workshop 2

11.30am - 1 hour - £5.00

Hedgerow Art *with Hilary Jackson (Quilters' Guild) (Friday Only)*

Create an original piece of art based on plants and seed heads commonly found in our hedgerows. In this mixed media class you will be shown how to combine fabric shapes embellished with simple embroidery stitches and water-colour crayons to produce an attractive piece just ready to place in a frame or mount on a canvas. All fabrics and threads will be provided in your kit and you will have the opportunity to experiment with a variety of crayons.

Felt Needlework Case *with Frankie White (Quilters' Guild) (Saturday Only)*

Create a delightful, colourful needle case using felt and embroidery stitches.

11.30am - 1 hour - £5.00

Kiltie Pins *with Gilli Theokritoff (Quilters' Guild) (Sunday Only)*

Kiltie pins are little brooches made from a kilt pin and some scraps of tweed, wool and some felted wool balls with embroidery stitches.

12.45pm - 1 hour - £5.00

Manx Log Cabin with Fiona Burrows (Quilters' Guild) (Friday Only)

Learn a traditional hand quilting technique, using just fabric, needle and thread and make a small square.

12.45pm - 1 hour - £5.00

Diamonds Are Forever with Claire Goode (Quilters' Guild) (Saturday Only)

In this class you will learn all about English Paper Piecing and work on a small piece incorporating diamonds.

12.45pm - 1 hour - £5.00

Hitomezashi with Gilli Theokritoff (Quilters' Guild) (Sunday Only)

This sounds rather alarming, but you will be learning a form of sashiko running stitch using straight lines, with coloured threads. Great fun and really interesting as you experiment to create beautifully textured fabric samples.

Exploring Japanese Boro with Susan Briscoe

Try making a traditional Japanese Boro rag patchwork inspired picture, using vintage Japanese fabrics. Easy hand sewing. Workshop pack includes vintage Japanese recycled fabrics, fine sashiko thread and sashiko needle. Beginners welcome.
