Workshop 1

11.15am - 1 Hour - £8.00

Marble & Make! *With Kate André*

Take home a marble style felt thread catcher/ gift box...

Learn to create 'marble-effect' fabric in this one hour taster class. This is a really easy and cheap method by which you can decorate all sorts and sizes of fabric easily at home. *Aprons and gloves provided. Suitable for everyone (children with an adult please).*

12.30pm - 1 Hour - £8.00

Cut. Stamp. Colour and Stitch! *With Kate André*

Have a brilliant time using pre-made stamps, or making and printing your own stamps with this super easy method. We will then colour and stitch our designs to take away! Perfect for making all sorts of craft and quilting projects. *Aprons and gloves provided. Suitable for everyone (children with an adult please).*

2.00pm - 1 Hour - £8.00

Gel-Print & Stitch! *With Kate André*

Spend a happy hour creating beautiful fabric panels using gel-plate, shapes, stencils and foliage. Learn all the tricks so you can produce unique designs easily at home. We will print fabric and then stitch into your work to produce a panel for a small book jacket, quilt panel or your own project. *Aprons and gloves provided. Suitable for everyone (children with an adult please).*

Workshop 2

3D Fabric Flowers *with Christine Badger*

This is an easy way to make 3D fabric flowers that are very durable and create shadows normally only achieved with paintings or photography with very little stitching.

Traditional Hand Quilted Draw Centre Piece / Mat *with Abbie Searle*

We'll be spending time hand quilting a design on a centre piece/mat, using template rulers designed by Abbie especially for these workshops. Learning how to use quilting templates to their best, traditional hand quilting with hints and tips, with a little extra time at home, this could become a small draw string bag or a bag motif....

Create a Beautiful Batik Landscape *with Roxana Pallatt (Hannah's Room)*

Join Roxana Pallatt as she shows you how to create a simple yet effective landscape using beautiful batik fabrics. Participants will complete the basics of this scene during the workshop and then add stitching and embellishment at home

Workshop 3

Embroidered Lacy Fabric with Jan Tillett (8 Max)

Using water soluble film you will create a delicate lacy fabric using snippets of thread, fabric, fibre and lace. Free motion stitching will be used to add pattern and texture. Your fabric can be used to create a small bowl, a tea light cover or be incorporated into a larger piece of work. Full instructions will be given and Jan will have a variety of samples showing how she uses this technique in her work.
