Workshop List

Some workshops will overlap so please check the times when making your choice. Workshops can be booked at the show on a first come, first served basis. Payment should be made by cash only.

Workshop 1

11.15am - 1 hour - £7.50

'Printing Paradise!' - Gel-Plate Printing *with Kate André*

Learn how to mono-print on paper and fabric using a gel-plate and print your own unique makeup bag/pencil case to take home. *Aprons and gloves provided. Suitable for everyone (children with an adult please).*

12.45pm - 1 hour - £7.50

'Mixed-Media Magic' - Print, Colour and Stitch *with Kate André*

Using stamps or screens, Kate will show you how to print a charming image onto your fabric. Using Inktense permanent pencils we will then colour our designs ready for simple stitching and embellishing. Take away your finished project in a sweet embroidery hoop to keep. *Aprons and gloves provided. Suitable for everyone (children with an adult please).*

2.00pm - 1 hour - £7.50

Indigo Dyeing *with Kate André*

Kate will show you her tried-and-tested super quick and easy method for mixing up the indigo dye. You can then spend a happy half hour folding, tying, wrapping and stitching fabric before immersing it in indigo. After rinsing, your items will be ready to take home. *Aprons and gloves provided. Suitable for everyone (children with an adult please).*

Workshop 2

Xmas Straight Curves *with Abbie Searle*

This reverse appliqué panel also has fusible web appliqué and 'self-cover' buttons included! Finished its approx. 10" x 10" ready for you to make your own choice of item at home – cushions, bags, wall hanging... All the machining for this monotone panel will already have been done for you. You'll get the fun bit of cutting things about, learn how to use fusible web and how to cover your own buttons. Suitable for any level of expertise.

Blooming Garden *with Maggie Davies*

While stitching this floral project, learn how to perfect needle-turn appliqué, smooth curves and perfect circles. Kit provided (no thimbles), project to be finished at home.

2.00pm - 1 hour - £6.50

Beautiful Bugs *with Gail Lawther*

Stitch a cute dragonfly or a striking butterfly, using Gail's simple fused design – contrasting blanket stitch and little buttons give them a folksy touch. All materials, threads and embellishments supplied.

Workshop 3

11.30am - 1 hour - £7.50

Free Woolly Textures with Catherine Lawes

In this class you will create a colourful, textured landscape or abstract picture using strips of wool fabrics, many varied textured yarns, stitched down with crewel wools in cross stitch or couching. All materials supplied.

12.45pm - 1 hour - £7.00

Japanese Boro Komebukuro Drawstring Bag with Susan Briscoe

Start making your own drawstring bag in the Japanese Boro 'rag patchwork' appliqué technique. Hand sewing. Suitable for beginners and upwards. Workshop kit includes Japanese cotton foundation fabric, recycled Japanese cotton and other scraps for the Boro appliqué, sashiko thread and sashiko needle.

Tactile Twiddled Daisy Design with Jennie Rayment

Create an eight-petal manipulated masterpiece. Simple to make yet divertingly unique. A novel creation from Jennie's latest book. Come and have fun fiddling with fabric – ideal for all ages and abilities. Full pre-cut kit provided to make a cushion or small hanging.

Workshop 4

11.30am - 1 hour - £7.00

Really Useful Pincushion with Gai Taylor

Hexagons and wool felt combine to produce this useful pincushion. You will learn the techniques used in wool felt appliqué, how to do the different stitches, as well as help on wool and thread colour selection for your project.

12.45pm - 1 hour - £5.00

Let the Thread Do the Talking with Grasby Embroiderers

Take the 'Slow Stitch' trend to learn the technique of Kantha work. With the beauty of variegated and space dyed threads, create a small stand-alone piece which could also be incorporated into quilts and more.

2.00pm - 1 hour - £7.00

Christmas Garland Flowers with Gai Taylor

Wool felt is used to construct Poinsettias, which can then be used to embellish wallhangings, napkins, placemats or napkin holders. Embroidery stitches are used to embellish the wool felt to make festive season projects.

Workshop 5

11.30am - 1 hour - £7.50

Stitching the Past with Yorkshire and the Humber Region Embroiderers' Guild

Learn the stitches originally used in the Bayeux Tapestry and currently being used to tell the story of the Battle of Stamford Bridge, by stitching a small motif from this tapestry. All materials will be provided.

12.45pm - 1 hour - £7.00

Birds for Any Occasion with Kim Shaw

Whether you want to represent a time of year or a special occasion, use your pattern in a number of ways to illustrate your ideas and thoughts. Add or subtract items to personalise for your intended recipient. Kit/pattern supplied.

2.00pm - 1 hour - £7.50

Embellished Felt Heart with Yorkshire and the Humber Region Embroiderers' Guild

Using hand embroidery stitches decorate a two-sided hanging felt heart which can be suspended by ribbon or a handmade cord. All materials and full instructions will be provided.

Workshop 6

11.30am - 1 hour - £7.00

Corded and Stuffed 3D Quilting with Sylvia Critcher

Create a 3D textile surface with trapunto, Italian quilting and my style of French cording. Combine these with English quilting and you will have an interesting design that looks complicated, but is very easy to do. For both beginners and experienced stitchers.

12.45pm - 1 hour - £7.00

Fusible Thread Appliqué with Sylvia Grayson

Learn the different ways in which you can use fusible thread: Single and multi-layered appliqué designs, challenging appliqué designs e.g. Celtic and art designs, trapunto designs and freehand foil and embellished designs. During this workshop you will have the opportunity to use fusible thread on a small project in order that you will feel comfortable to use the thread in your own projects at home. You will also learn tips and tricks that you can use in other patchwork and quilting projects. Level: Beginner to experienced. Workshop pack includes information, techniques and patterns.

2.00pm - 1 hour - £7.00

Mobile and Card Carrier with Jane Rollason

The holder has an interior pocket for cards or money. The black felt goes well with brightly coloured felt flower design which is embellished with coloured thread and finished with a blanket stitch. All material provided plus instructions if you haven't finished.
